It is brought to your kind notice that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has notified Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher Education Institution in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging.

All the Principals of Constituent and Affiliated Colleges are directed to follow the following recommendations to take suitable measures to curb ragging on campus:

- i. Installation of CCTV cameras in all vulnerable points in the campuses.
- ii. Extensive publicity by means of audio-visual aids.
- iii. Counseling sessions, workshops and placing posters.
- iv. Arrange for periodic psychological counseling and orientation.
- v. Inclusion of one female member in the Anti-Ragging committee.
- vi. The committee whenever taken action under Anti-Ragging Act must note the satisfaction level of the student/parent/guardian before closure of the case.

The Head of Institutions should submit weekly or fortnightly reports to the University during the first three months of new Academic Year on the status of compliance with Anti-Ragging measures.

The following important measures were discussed in the Anti-Ragging Monitoring Committee under the Chairmanship of Dr.A.K.Raghuvaran at New Delhi are as detailed below:

 - Inclusion of one female member in the Anti-Ragging committee
 - The committee whenever taken action under Anti-Ragging Act must note the satisfaction level of the student / parent/ guardian before closure of the case.
 - Follow up action on psychological studies in educational institutions on Anti-Ragging menace.
